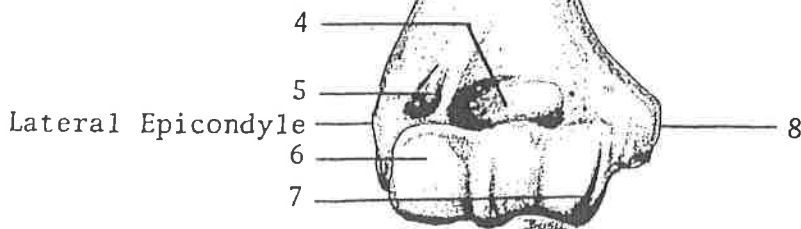

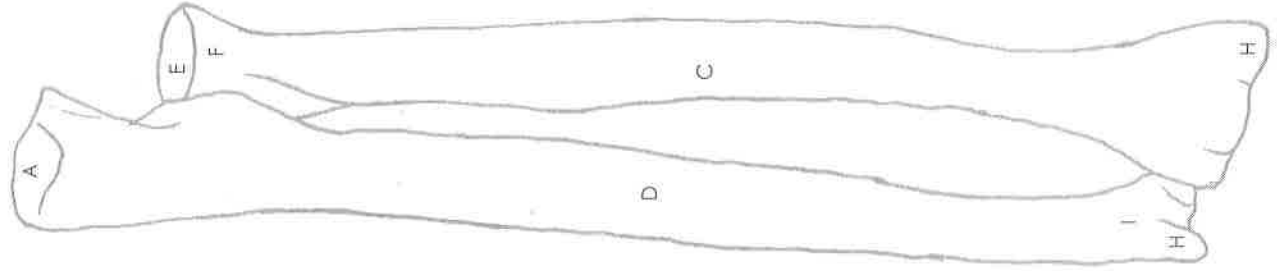
Figure IV-4: Right Humerus (anterior view)

Figure IV-5: Right Humerus (posterior view)

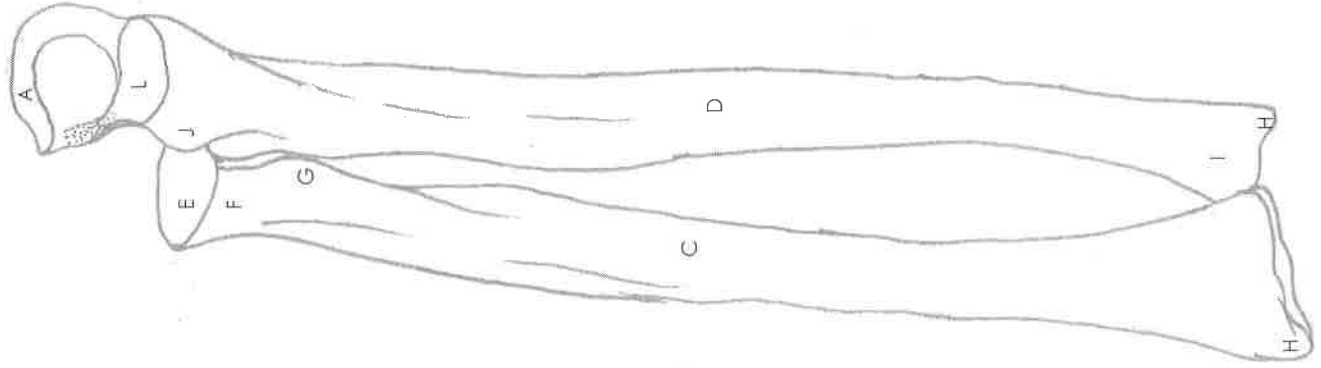

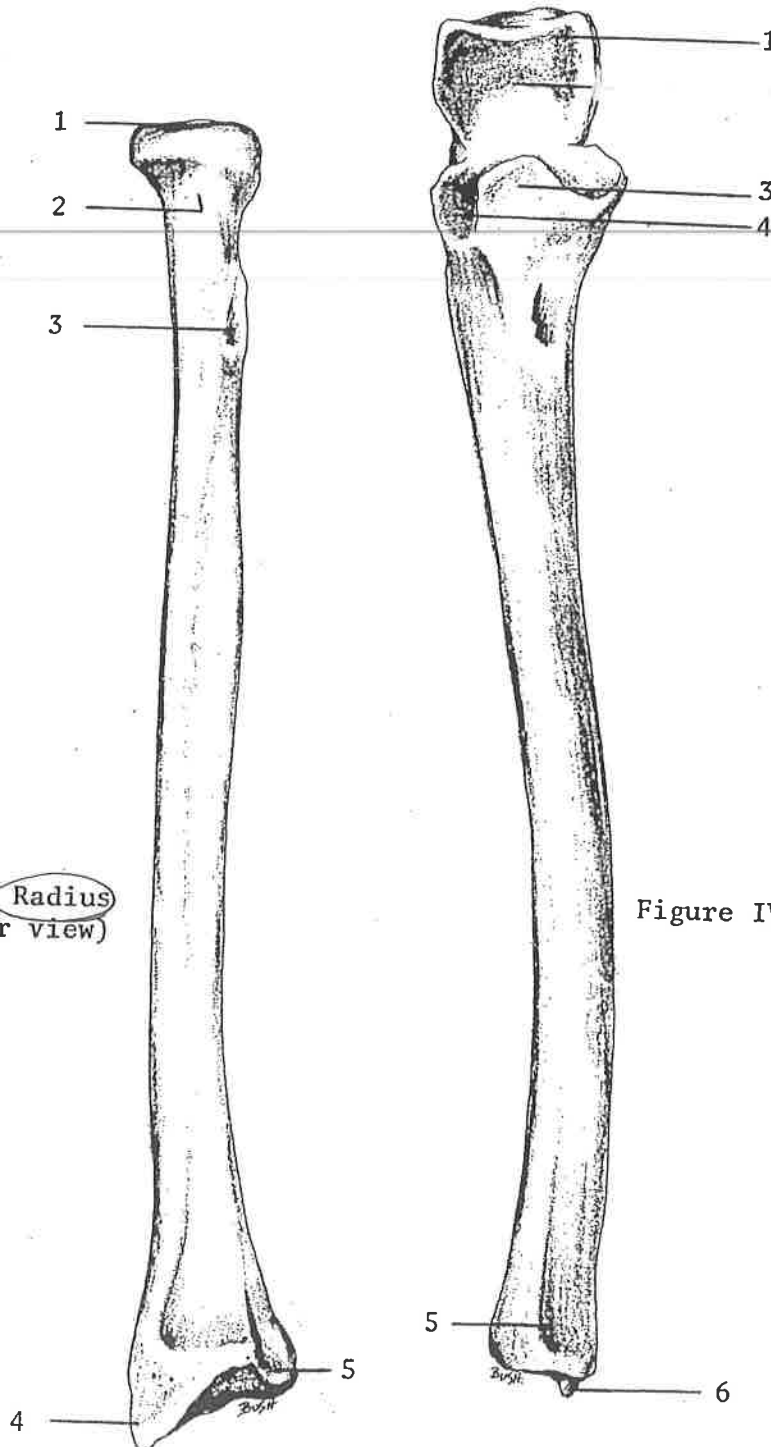
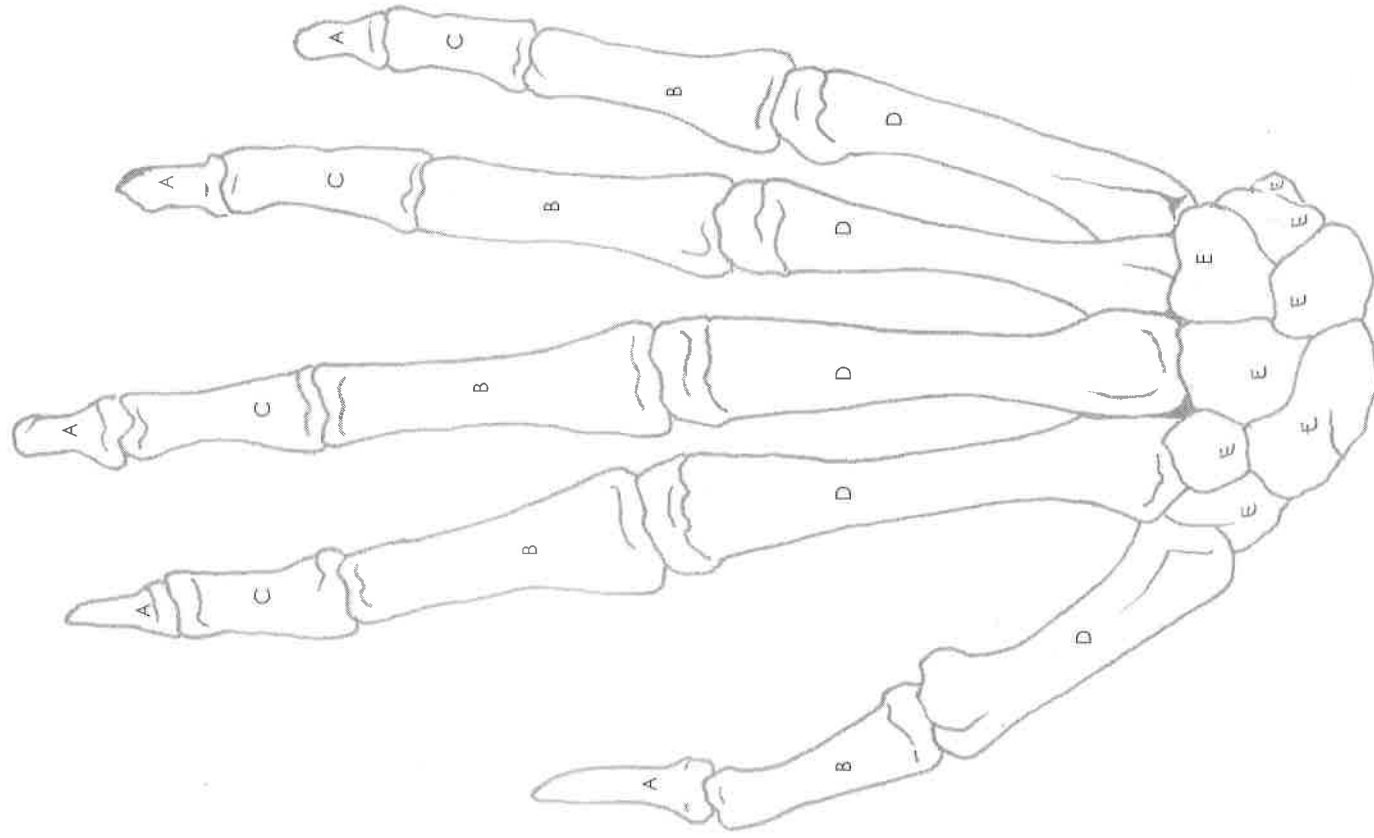


Figure IV-6: Right Radius (anterior view)
